

## **Datganiad Grant Amddifadedd Disgyblion Ysgol Gynradd Aberporth 2015/2016**

Dyrennir y Grant Amddifadedd Disgyblion i ysgolion â disgyblion sy'n dod o deuluoedd incwm isel ac y gwyddys eu bod ar hyn o bryd yn gymwys i dderbyn prydau ysgol am ddim (PYDd) a phlant mewn gofal yn barhaus am fwy na chwe mis (PMG).

Disgwylir i ysgolion ddefnyddio'r cyllid hwn i'r eithaf i gyflwyno strategaethau cynaliadwy fydd yn arwain yn gyflym at newidiadau i ddysgwyr sy'n gymwys i dderbyn prydau ysgol am ddim neu sy'n PMG.

Fel ysgol rydym wedi cytuno ar y camau canlynol:

1. nodi'r grŵp targed o ddisgyblion, ei nodweddion a'i anghenion
2. cynllunio ymyrraethau sy'n gwneud y defnydd mwyaf effeithiol o adnoddau er mwyn datblygu eu sgiliau llythrennedd a rhifedd drwy gyfrwng grwpiau ymyrraeth megis Satpin/Trandep, Dyfal Donc/Catch Up, Cyfri Ceredigion, Hwb Ymlaen; ynghyd ag ymyrraeth i gwrrdd ag anghenion emosiynol a chymdeithasol megis grŵp maethu "y cwtsh" a SULP "Talkabout"
3. monitro a gwerthuso effaith adnoddau
4. darparu gwisg ysgol a dillad addysg gorfforol ail-law
5. darparu ail arweinydd y Clwb Pyramid (Haf 2015)
6. darparu profiadau cyfoethog/ymweliadau addysgol
7. cyfrannu tuag at gostau aelodaeth yr Urdd
8. cyfrannu tuag at wersi peripatetig

Yn Ysgol Gynradd Aberporth mae gennym gynllun cynhwysfawr, sydd wedi'i gytuno a'i fonitro gan Awdurdod Lleol Sir Ceredigion ac ERW, i hyrwyddo cynnydd a chael gwared ar rwystrau i ddysgu i fyfyrwyr sy'n gymwys ar gyfer y cyllid hwn.

Rydym wedi defnyddio'r cyllid sydd ar gael i:

- ddarparu ymyrraeth a chymorth i ddatblygu medrau cymdeithasol ac emosiynol y dysgwyr
- sytyried dulliau uniongyrchol i ddelio ag anghenion penodol dysgwyr dan anfantais
- wrando ar y dysgwyr a rhoi cyfle iddynt gymryd rhan lawn ym mywyd yr ysgol

## Pupil Deprivation Grant (PDG) Statement 2015-2016

### Ysgol Gynradd Aberporth

The Pupil Deprivation Grant (PDG) is allocated to schools with pupils who come from low-income families and are currently known to be eligible for free school meals (FSM) and pupils who have been looked after continuously for more than six months (LAC).

Schools are expected to make the best use of this funding to implement sustainable strategies that will quickly bring about changes for learners eligible for free school meals or who are LAC.

As a school we have agreed the following steps:

- to identify the target group of pupils, its characteristics and needs
- to plan interventions which make the most effective use of resources in order to develop literacy and numeracy skills through various intervention programmes such as Satpin/Trandep, Dyfal Donc/Catch Up, Cyfri Ceredigion, Springboard; including intervention programmes to meet pupil's social and emotional needs such as the nurture group "y cwtsh" and SULP "Talkabout"
- to monitor and evaluate the impact of resources
- to provide second hand school uniform and P.E. kit
- to provide a second leader at the Pyramid Club (held in Summer 2015)
- to provide enriched learning experiences/educational visits
- to contribute towards the Urdd membership
- to contribute towards peripatetic lessons

At Ysgol Gynradd Aberporth, we have a comprehensive plan, agreed and monitored by Ceredigion Local Authority and ERW, to promote progress and remove barriers to learning for students eligible for this funding. We have used the funding available to:

- provide intervention and support to develop the social and emotional skills of the learners
- focus on pastoral care and deal more directly with the specific needs of disadvantaged learners
- to listen to disadvantaged learners and provide opportunities for them to participate fully in school life
